## FOUNDATION PRESENTS \$10,000 IN 1998 SCHOLARSHIPS AND TEACHER GRANTS

The Brookland-Cayce High School Foundation was established to collect funds and disburse funds in the form of scholarships and teacher grants. In its first year, the Foundation has been successful in distributing the Jarvis Klapman Scholarship, the Southern Anesthesia and Surgical Inc. Scholarship, the Mary Ann Dreher Hook Academic Achievement Award, the Maysey-Hagins Scholarship, and the Barry Bolen Scholarship for a total of **\$5,000**.

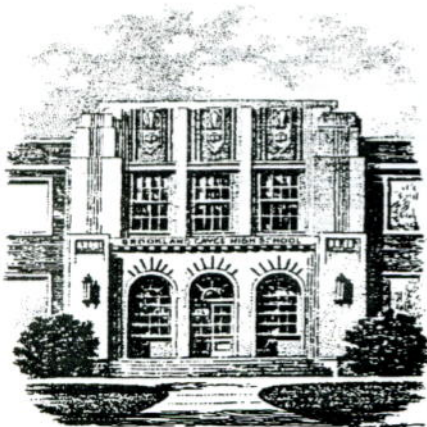
In addition to the scholarships, the Foundation also gave \$5,835 in teacher grants for use in classroom programs. Awards were made to the following departments at Brookland-Cayce High School: Foreign Language Lab — \$2,000 for software,

Math Department — \$250 for computer software, PE Department — \$1,185 for Outdoor Living Course, Science Department — \$900 for microscopes repairs, Social Studies Department — \$1,000 for Literacy Class Documentary Project, and Special Ed Department — \$500 for Student Employability Project.
